

Kitchen Assistant 1-Year Contract Position

JOB DESCRIPTION:

This position must provide clean, orderly and satisfying surroundings in the vegetarian kitchen at the International Art of Living Centre, Canada. It also entails vegetarian food prep and cooking. This is a one-year contract position.

Duties:

- Clean the kitchen and other work areas so that sanitary standards are met.
- Keep kitchen equipment clean
- Sweep, scrub floors, using brooms, mops, and/or powered scrubbing.
- Keep storage areas well-stocked, clean, and tidy.
- Assign duties to other staff and give instructions regarding work methods and routines.
- Purchase or order groceries to keep kitchen stocked, and record expenditures.
- Prepare one vegetarian meal each day
- Follow the menus prepared by the chief cook

Physical Requirements:

• This position demands good physical and mental health. The kitchen assistant will be required to lift, carry, walk, push, pull, be on their feet for long hours and work a flexible schedule.
